

Firestore ^9.0.0

The latest version of firestore i.e ^9.0.0 seems to not work with the steps mentioned in the lectures of firestore. So if you are facing such issues, you are advised to use [npm install firestore@8.10.0](#) instead of [npm install firestore](#) to install the v8.10.0 of firestore.

Working with Firestore ^9.0.0

If you want to work with the v9 of firestore instead, follow the instructions below:

- Instead of the following code from v8

```
import firestore from 'firebase/app';
import 'firebase/firestore';
```

- Use this to import firestore to your application:

```
import firestore from 'firebase/compat/app';
import 'firebase/compat/firestore';
```
